Free food pantries in Larimer County Colorado.

A number of churches, charities, and other organizations across Fort Collins and Larimer County Colorado can distribute free food, meals, and groceries to the needy. The leading distribution centers to call or stop by at are below. Most locations are open limited hours and can also provide only a select amount of groceries or emergency boxes of food over a defined period of time. Other charities only serve hot meals as a last resort to the needy.

Many of the food pantries in Larimer County also have staff and volunteers who will talk to people who need help. They can provide them with additional information such as details on public aid, applications to SNAP food stamps, clothing closets, and programs such as LIHEAP. So these food banks are a great place to turn to for advice, support, and of course, a box of groceries and meals.

Loveland Vineyard Community Church – Distributes non-perishable food and groceries such as fruit, peanut butter, tuna, canned vegetables, cereal, pasta, rice, soups, crackers, beans, tomato sauce, and other incidentals. Free food is provided to the needy on a short-term basis, and groceries are supplied to individuals requesting aid at no cost. Except in a crisis situation, recipients of the resources offered need to have a Food Stamp card from Colorado. Aid is only offered at most once per month, and farm workers and migrants can qualify too.
